SUBJECT: PROMPT NOTIFICATION IN THE EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY

10 CFR 50, Appendix E, Section IV.D.3 requires applicants for nuclear power reactor licenses for power operation to demonstrate that administrative and physical means have been established for alerting and providing prompt instructions to the public within the plume exposure EPZ in the event of an emergency. As part of our review for an operating license for Shoreham, please provide confirmation within 30 days after receipt of this letter that a prompt notification system will be installed including a schedule for installation, a description of the system, and a description or listing of the problems that may hinder implementation. Your verification that a public notification system meeting the regulations is in place is required prior to issuance of a license for power operation. We expect that the Federal Emergency Management Agency will review the adequacy of the system by evaluating the results of an actual system test, probably during the joint exercise of your facility with offsite authorities.
