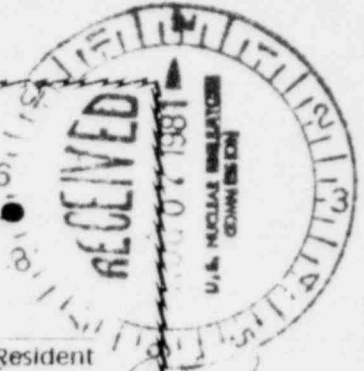

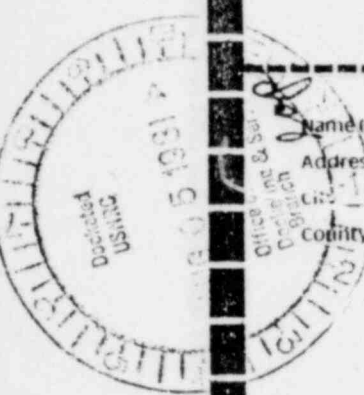

Dear Sir:

1. I am adamantly opposed to licensing the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power plant. It sits right smack on top of an active earthquake fault -according to latest information - not at the previously touted 2 1/2 miles distance! Your own rules call for a 12 mile distance. How can you or anyone else even think of licensing a plant which so blatantly violates your own rules?
2. The Diablo Canyon Nuclear plant is not needed now, nor will it be in the foreseeable future. Conservation is working and it is far less costly!
3. As long as the Diablo Canyon plant is nuclear, it is a risk and unsafe - otherwise: why is an emergency plan necessary? So why not convert it to conventional fuel -as has been done in three other instances lately - thus saving P.G. & E.'s investment in the plant while, at the same time, putting a stop to all agitation and protest in the community, not to speak of the actual monetary savings, considering the short life span of a nuclear installation and the huge costs of frequent shut-downs and eventual decommissioning?
4. The county emergency plan make no provision for a severe earthquake and accompanying nuclear disaster and is thus completely inadequate. Moreover, evacuation from this region is virtually impossible and even the threat of evacuation a nightmare!

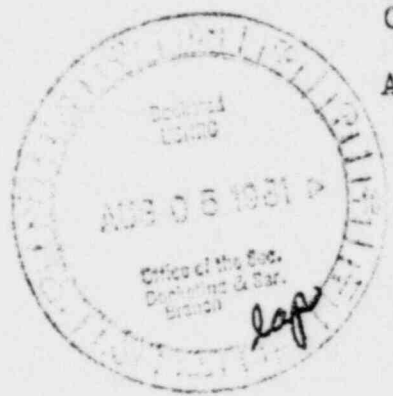

Dear Sir:

I am absolutely opposed to licensing the Diablo Canyon Nuclear plant. It is not needed now, nor at any time in the foreseeable future. Conservation does the job and is far cheaper!

I oppose licensing Diablo Canyon: it clearly violates NRC rules which specify a distance of 12 miles from any active earthquake fault. Diablo Canyon is situated right on top of such a fault -according to the latest information- not even at the distance of 2 1/2 miles as previously proclaimed!

As long as Diablo Canyon is nuclear, it presents a risk -otherwise: why should we need an emergency plan? Three other nuclear plants have been converted to conventional fuel lately; so why not convert the Diablo Canyon plant? It would remove a lot of agitation in the community and make all those protests unnecessary; it would even save money for the embattled P.G. & E. Co. in the end, considering the short life span of nuclear installations as well as the tremendous cost of eventual decommissioning, not to mention the all too frequently occurring shut-downs.

Yes, we now have a county emergency plan. But this plan makes absolutely no provision for a severe earthquake taking place at the same time as a nuclear disaster. It is therefore completely inadequate for this most likely scenario. Moreover: have you ever tried to get out of this locality? Under the above condition, it would be an impossibility.

I urge you to not license Diabale Canyon even for "testing"!
