THE REPORT DETAILS CONTAIN 10 CFR 2.790 INFORMATION

The inspection involved 92 inspector-hours onsite by two regional based NRC inspectors. The inspection began during regular hours; 24 inspector-hours were accomplished during offshift periods.

<u>Results</u>: The licensee was found to be in compliance with NRC requirements within the twenty areas examined during the inspection except for the following three items:

- 1. Access Control Failure to enforce identification badge procedures.
- Assessment Aids Inadequate CCTV coverage of the perimeter and isolation zones.
- 3. Records and Reports Failure to complete alarm response records.
