

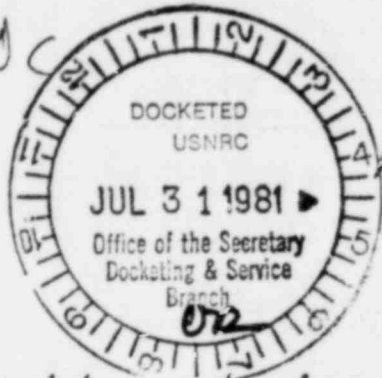

Reference: Comments on Safety Goals

Dear Sir,

The safety goals for operating nuclear plants should be stated simply:

"The number of deaths caused by the operation of nuclear plants should be held to one tenth of the deaths caused by the electricity coming from nuclear plants."

You already have excellent data on the probability of death caused by accidental electrocution, so you should be able to place a safety goal on the plants which generate the electricity. This goal should apply uniformly to all electricity plants; however, I doubt that coal plants, with their air pollution, could meet this standard.
