Draft Regulatory Guide and Value/Impact Statement TASK TP-019-4, "Establishing Quality Assurance Programs for Packaging Used in the Transport of Special Form and Certain Normal Form Radioactive Material".

This submittal is in response to the June 1981 publication of the subject document soliciting comments. Our comments are as follows:

- 1. The Regulatory Position and Draft/value Impact Statement should acknowledge licensee Quality Assurance Programs previously approved by the Commission in accordance with 10CFR71 Part 71.51(d).
- 2. The term, "licensee user" is not defined in Annex 2 of the guide. Licensee - user should be defined so that applicability of Annex 2 to organizations other than the licensee who owns the package may be determined.
- 3. The "graded" approach to quality assurance described in Appendix A, should provide specific guidance for determining which structures, systems, and components are Category A, B, and C.
