Subject: MAIN TURBINE FAILURE

At 0315 hours (PDT) on August 13, 1981, while operating at 90 percent full power, indication of high vibration (off-scale) and high conductivity in hotwell (indicative of turbine blade failure) caused an immediate controlled shutdown. The main generator output breakers were opened at approximately 0345 hours Auxiliary feedwater was initiated with suction from the condensate storage tank to k ... impure condensate out of the steam generators.

This is a controlled normal shutdown procedure and the plant is expected to be in cold shutdown by 1700 hours(PDT) today. Preliminary evaluation of the damage indicates that pressure simulation baffles may have failed. These were put in the turbine during the last outage, to make up for damaged blades that were removed.

The total extent of damage and repairs will not be known until about August 21. At present, estimates of repair time are approximately 60 days.

The licensee is continuing investigation; the resident inspectors are following the licensee's progress.

Media interest is expected. The licensee is preparing a press release.
