This is to advise you that the Commission (with three Commissioners approving) has reviewed the subject license amendments to Westinghouse Electric Corporation and General Electric Company. The Commission (with three Commissioners approving) has accepted your recommendation to amend the subject licenses to export to Spain an additional 234,187.56 kilograms of uranium, enriched to a maximum of 3.8% U-235, in the form of fuel assemblies. Commissioner Ahearne was not available to participate in this action.
