QA for Design & Construction

1. SNUPPS General -

Figures 17A.1-1 and 17A.1-2 indicate that TPO has been eliminated and the Bechtel Power Corporation has been formed. However, Figure 17A.1-3 and Section 17A.1.1.1 still refer to TPO. Figure 17A.1-6 shows MF&QCS supporting TPO, and there is no indication on the figures where the MF&QCS Department reports. Also, Figure 17A.1-10 refers to TPO quality policies, and Section 17A.1.1.2 discusses TPO. Clarify.

2. Callaway - The two new paragraphs at the top of page 17.1-5 assign quality assurance activities to "utility technical support personnel" and to the Manager, Nuclear Engineering. Discuss the involvement of Union Electric's Quality Assurance organization in these activities.
3. Callaway - The changes on page 17.1-9 change the responsibilities for preoperational testing from the Plant Superintendent to the Manager, Nuclear Construction, and the corresponding QA program from operating (per FSAR) to design and construction (per Post-CP information). Discuss the involvement of the Plant Superintendent, his staff, and the Operations QA Group in the preoperational test program.
4. Callaway - The new paragraph on page 17.1-28 assigns responsibilities to the site QA group leader. It appears this should be the Superintendent, Site QA. Clarify.
5. Wolf Creek - Item f on page 17B-6 indicates the Daniel Construction Manager is responsible to "Disposition nonconforming items." What are the QA controls applicable to this activity?

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
