Subject: Technical Specification Revision for Snubber Surveillance

Pursuant to Section 50.59 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, Yankee Atomic Electric Company hereby proposes the following amendment to Appendix A of the Facility License.

PROPOSED CHANGE:

This change modifies the Inservice Surveillance requirements for snubbers. The revised pages are provided as an attachment to this letter.

REASON FOR CHANGE:

This change, as requested by the USNRC, incorporates the applicable portions of the revised Standard Technical Specifications which clarifies and improves the surveillance requirements for snubbers.

BASIS FOR CHANGE:

The modifications to our Technical Specifications are based on the description of the surveillance requirements for snubbers as described in Reference (2).

SAFETY CONSIDERATION:

The proposed Technical Specification modifications will not endanger the health and safety of the public. This proposed change has been reviewed by the Nuclear Safety Audit and Review Committee.

FEE DETERMINATION:

This proposed change is administrative in nature and has no safety or environmental significance. For these reasons, Yankee Atomic Electric Company proposes this change as a Class II amendment. A payment of \$1,200.00 is enclosed.
