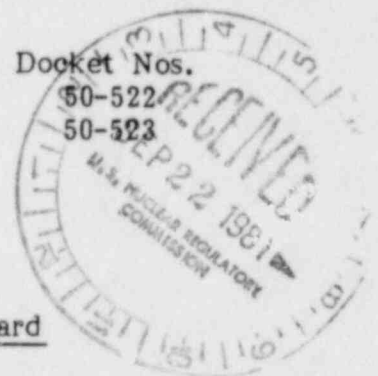

Dismissal of Motion by
Coalition for Safe Power and Forelaws on Board

1. By letter of August 18, 1981, the Coalition for Safe Power (CSP) and Forelaws on Board (FOB) jointly moved for an Order "causing all parties to the Skagit/Hanford Construction Permit proceedings to commence full service of all documents in the case to the above-mentioned organizations, at their respective offices, pending renote of this matter (scheduled for Winter 1981) and rulings on requests for leave to intervene."

2. The Board is not disposed to issue premature Orders as the one requested by the Coalition for Safe Power and Forelaws on Board, especially when there is no showing that the moving parties have first tried themselves to resolve their prospective difficulty.

3. According to the NRC Staff, when this proceeding involved the Skagit site, CSP was a joint intervenor with FOB and all documents were served on Mr. Marbet of FOB as representative of both intervenors. During the present transition stage of this proceeding pending amendment to the application, all appropriate documents

pertainig to the application and its amendment have continued to be served on Mr. Marbet on behalf of FOB and CSP. By way of further note, the Applicants' mailing list dated August 11, 1981 which accompanied Amendment No. 21 to the Preliminary Safety Analysis Report for Skagit/Hanford Nuclear Project includes the following:
