



TO FILE RESPONSE TO MOTIONS REGARDING  
INTERVENORS ADDITIONAL CONTENTIONS



Intervenors request a nine day extension, until October 9, 1981 to file response to motions concerning additional contentions filed by Intervenors on September 4, 1981. Extensive motions and objections have been filed by the Staff and Licensee attacking the right of Intervenors to file the contentions, which must be answered after considerable legal research as well as a search of the record in this proceeding. In addition, Intervenors are consulting with experts to set out the basis for the contentions and the threat to health and safety of the public involved. Because Intervenors lacks funds to pay experts, we must rely upon volunteer expert assistance which does not always respond as quickly as the highly paid experts employed by Licensee.
