On July 21, 1981 in Silver Springs. Maryland, the TVA staff met with members of your staff, the Office of Nuclear Materials Safety and Safeguards (NMSS) and the Office of Inspection and Enforcement (IE) concerning physical security provisions at the Browns Ferry Nuclear Plant. At the meeting there was a brief discussion of the problems at Browns Ferry with regard to compartmentalizing Class 1 vital areas. Mr. Charles Gaskin of NMSS suggested that those problems be documented formally to the NRC.
