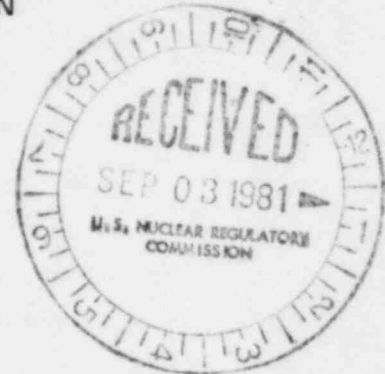

Dear Mr. Silberg:

This is in further response to your letter dated July 10, 1981, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, three categories of information concerning 10 CFR 73.

In my letter to you dated August 12, 1981, I stated that seven documents were undergoing review. We have now completed our review and these documents, as listed in Appendix A, are enclosed.

The charge for reproducing the documents is five cents (\$0.05) per page, as specified in 10 CFR 9.14(b). Accordingly, the cost of reproducing 348 pages is \$17.40.

Physical Protection of Power Reactors

Dear Sir:

Pursuant to 10 CFR §9.8, I hereby request copies of the following records relating to NRC requirements for physical protection of power reactors:

1. All records relating to the requirement in 10 CFR §73.55(d)(2) that all hand-carried packages be searched for certain specified devices. Of particular interest are those records which relate to the need to apply this requirement to packages hand-carried by regular employees of the licensee.
2. All records relating to the requirement in 10 CFR §73.70(d) that nuclear power reactor licensees maintain a log indicating the time of exit of all individuals granted access to a normally unoccupied vital area.



3. All records relating to the requirement in Sections I.C and E of Appendix B to 10 CFR Part 73 for an annual physical fitness demonstration for certain personnel and that the physical fitness demonstration be held within 30 days after a medical examination. Of particular interest are those records which relate to (a) the frequency of the physical fitness demonstration, (b) the frequency of the medical examination, and (c) the requirement that the physical fitness demonstration be held within 30 days of the medical examination.
