Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Dr. J. B. Nicholas of this office during the period November 13-17, 1989, of activities authorized by NRC Construction Permits CPPR-126 and CPPR-127 for Comanche Peak Steam Electric Station, Units 1 and 2, and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. C. B. Hogg and other members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection on November 17, 1989.

Areas examined during this preoperational inspection included the liquid and gaseous radioactive waste systems, radioactive waste management program, water chemistry and radiochemistry programs, and plant systems affecting plant water chemistry. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector. The inspection findings are documented in the enclosed inspection report.

Within the scope of the inspection, no violations or deviations were identified.

We have also examined actions you have taken with regard to previously identified inspection findings. The status of these items is identified in paragraph 2 of the enclosed report.
