Commonwealth Edison requested Technical Specification Amendments in references (a) and (b). With the recent implementation of our Technical Specification Improvement Project, Commonwealth Edison is applying higher standards for the technical and administrative quality of our submittals. A recent review of the submittals made prior to the implementation of these improvement efforts, by members of your staff as well as Commonwealth Edison, indicates that the quality of these submittals does not meet the expectations of our company and your staff. Therefore, Commonwealth Edison requests that these applications for Technical Specification Amendments be withdrawn at this time.

Commonwealth Edison will be making new requests for Technical Specification Amendments in these areas in the future utilizing our new guidelines to assure that submittals meet our improved standards. Please direct any questions regarding this matter to this office.
