In accordance with the conditions for exemption from 10 CFR 50.46(a)(1) noted in Reference 1, a plant-specific emergency core cooling system (ECCS) cooling evaluation has been prepared for SQN. The results of the analysis were submitted to NRC as justification for upper head injection (UHI) removal in Reference 2. The ECCS evaluation will be valid for SQN upon completion of the modifications associated with UHI removal. TVA will be in compliance with 10 CFR 50.46(a)(1) upon start-up from the Cycle 4 refueling outage for each unit.
