
Gentlemen:

This schedule for submittal of FSAR Amendment 63 contemplated prior issuance of a full power operating license, to ensure that the amended FSAR reflected any requirements accompanying the license, the latest technical specifications and plant procedures, and any changes necessitated by the Power Ascension Test Program.
