Dear Mr. Berson:

As discussed in my January 29, 1990 letter, AMS is very concerned with the volume of documents compiled to form its license. As admitted by NRC employees, it is unusual for a license to contain so many documents. As you are aware, AMS waited over five (5) years for its license renewal which was not received until the December, 1989. Prior to that time, AMS had no input from the NRC as to what types of documents would be utilized as license conditions. Neither were we provided an opportunity to comment on these documents.

Since the NRC has chosen to make AMS' Isotope Safety Procedures (ISP) license conditions, it is imperative that the NRC cooperate in assuring that it has the most current procedures. For instance, Mr. John Madera, who professed to be the "expert" in AMS' license was unaware of the fact that our Emergency Evacuation Plan is contained right in Appendix B of the ISP's and was supplied to satisfy License Condition 15C.

As I stated earlier, AMS is in the process of streamlining and updating its procedures.

I have attempted to elicit some form of cooperation from Region III. To date, however, my attempts to work with Region III have resulted in further attempts by them to "find things wrong". Additionally, AMS Inspector Wayne Slawinski has continued to contact numerous AMS employees in a vigorous attempt to find a discrepancy between statements made. I, therefore, lack reasonable assurances that Region III has any intention of cooperating in an attempt to clarify AMS' license. Because of this, I am formally requesting that I receive the commitment in writing from Region III that they will cooperate in this matter.
