Report of Changes to Emergency Plan

In accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(q)(5) and 10 CFR 72.44(f), Florida Power & Light (FPL) hereby submits a description of changes to the St. Lucie Radiological Emergency Plan and a summary of the analysis demonstrating that the changes do not reduce the effectiveness of the plan. The plan, as changed, continues to meet the requirements in 10 CFR 50 Appendix E and the planning standards of 10 CFR 50.47(b). The changes were incorporated in Revision 68 of the St. Lucie Radiological Emergency Plan dated December 18, 2019.

Description of Changes and Summary of Analysis

The St. Lucie Radiological Emergency Plan was revised to:

1. Revise the State Notification Form. The revised form was an agreement that was reached between the licensee, State and County officials.
2. Revise the PAR flowchart. The revised flowchart aligns with the revised notification form.

These changes were evaluated in accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(q)(3), and it was determined that these changes did not reduce the effectiveness of the St. Lucie Radiological Emergency Plan.
