Dear Mr. Castle:

This is in reference to your letter dated August 21, 2019, requesting a change of control for NRC License No. 47-31035-01. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

You stated that ArcelorMittal Mid Vol Group and ArcelorMittal Mining Equipment LLC merged into ArcelorMittal USA Holdings, II, LLC. You provided Exhibit B as evidence of this merger. However, Exhibit B only provided documentation that ArcelorMittal USA Holdings, II, LLC agreed to changes in the directors of Mid-Vol Coal Sales Inc.

- a. Please provide documentation detailing the merger of these entities, including the date of the transaction, parties involved, and commitments to maintain compliance with NRC license requirements
- b. Please provide organizational charts for Mid-Vol Coal Sales, Inc., as well as any corporate entities having direct oversight of Mid-Vol Coal Sales, Inc. The organizational charts should describe the organizations before and after both the 2008 sale and the subsequent merger (date unknown), including any changes in Mid-Vol Coal Sales, Inc. management and radiation safety staff.

We will continue our review upon receipt of the requested information. You may respond to my attention in writing by letter or email (if letter is signed by senior management and scanned into a pdf format), referencing mail control number 615335.
