Re: FOIL Request for records related to the Indian Point Energy Center

Dear Mr. Nelson:

I am writing on behalf of Riverkeeper, Inc.—a member-supported environmental watchdog organization dedicated to defending the Hudson River and its tributaries and to protecting the drinking water supply of nine million New York City and Hudson Valley residents—seeking copies of agency records pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (“FOIA”), 5 U.S.C. § 552.

I request true and complete copies of the following records related to Indian Point Energy Center (“IPEC”), located in Buchanan, NY, which are in the Nuclear Regulatory Commission’s (“NRC”) possession, custody or control:

1. The Master Decommissioning Trust Agreement(s) or any other documents and agreements governing the management and use of the decommissioning trust fund for IPEC Units 1, 2, and 3, including any and all amendments or supporting documents.

I look forward to receiving a response within twenty (20) business days of receipt of this request, as required by NRC’s regulations, 10 C.F.R. § 9.25. If this request is denied, either in whole or in part, please include a detailed explanation for the denial in your response along with the statutory basis for your claim and your reasons for not exercising your discretion to release this information. If your office determines that any portions of the requested records are exempt from disclosure, please provide the remaining non-exempt portions. I reserve the right to appeal and/or to judicially challenge any determination by NRC to withhold any requested records, or any portions thereof.

Please respond to this request on a rolling basis, providing responsive records as they are found. If any of the requested records are available electronically, please e-mail them to me at the address below in lieu of providing hard copies.

Please inform me in advance if the costs associated with this request, including the cost of providing hard copies in the event that electronic records are unavailable, will exceed twenty-five dollars. Riverkeeper intends to use this information to benefit the public and will not be using the material for any commercial purposes, and therefore should qualify for search and duplication of records without charge, 10 C.F.R. § 9.39.
