Pursuant to 10 CFR 2.790(d)(1) and 10 CFR 9.5, this information should be considered confidential and withheld from public disclosure.

The enclosure also contains the response to Nuclear Regulatory Commission comments on the Grand Gulf Nuclear Station Physical Security Plan, Revision 5, sent to this office by Mr. Albert Schwencer, on November 22, 1982, MAEC-82/274.

The enclosed revisions to the Physical Security Plan were approved by the MP&L Plant Safety Review Committee (PSRC) on March 4, 1983.

MP&L has evaluated this revision and determined that it does not decrease the effectiveness of the Physical Security Plan. This notification, prior to two months following implementation of the revision, is in compliance with 10 CFR 50.54(p).


