SUBJECT: MEETING WITH PRESIDENT OF A NUCLEAR PLANT CONTRACTOR

REGARDING POTENTIAL ALLEGATIONS

Mrs. C. Z. Dezutel, President of the Zack Corporation, contacted me by telephone the morning of April 30, 1982, and asked to meet with me at 10:00 a.m. in my office. I granted the request and checked with Bob Warnick and Bill Little prior to the meeting to verify we had no pending allegations or enforcement action involving the Zack Corporation. (The Zack Corporation is a heating and ventilation contractor at several nuclear plants including Clinton, LaSalle, and Midland.)

Mrs. Dezutel stated that the purpose of her requested meeting was to inform the NRC that she was going to terminate several employees in the company document control section and anticipated that following this action, the employees would grieve in the form of allegations to either the NRC or the Labor Department.

She said she was having continuing difficulty with the head of the document control section and several clerks that worked for him in that they were not properly performing their job and repeatedly tried to extend their authority beyond the job they were hired to do. Further, she said the head of the section was observed removing an unknown quantity of records from the company property and it was for those reasons she was terminating their employment.

She stated that she did not know what records were removed and that an audit of more than 30 document packages had not identified any missing records. She added that as a precaution she had subsequently secured the records and placed them under lock and key but that they were available for NRC review at any time. She said she was painfully aware of the importance of good records from the experience her firm had at Midland.

I told Mrs. Dezutel that I was not aware of any allegations involving her firm at this time and that if allegations were received in the future she would be notified in due time.
