On April 11, 1983, while reviewing the vessel head installation work package, it was discovered that the head flange and vessel flange thermocouples had not been physically reinstalled during the insulation installation. The surveillance requirements of Technical Specification 4.4.6.1.4 were not met. The event is reported pursuant to Technical Specification 6.9.1.13.b.
