Control Program Status Report

Gentlemen:

This is our fourth monthly report on the progress of the Regulatory Response and Commitment Control Program. Following is a discussion of progress on each major area of the program that we are required to report status.

1. Verification of implementation of commitments made since January 1, 1979.

We stated in our status report to you dated April 14, 1983 (2CANØ483Ø4), that 15 items (other than for fire protection) remain open. Work on these open items is progressing and all open items are on schedule to be closed out by June 1, 1983.

The 13 fire protection open items are being addressed concurrently with the development of Appendix R issues. Our schedule for completion of these 13 items is now August 31, 1983.

2. Procedure revision and commitment tracking.

As discussed in our April 25, 1983 (ØCANØ48321), letter to you, Licensing procedures will be revised and issued by May 27, 1983.

The passive commitment tracking issue is currently under review, and a detailed needs assessment report is being developed. The formal report is scheduled for issuance August 1, 1983.

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

3. Priority scheme for nuclear regulatory issues.

We have completed the review of our priority assignment scheme. We now plan to test this scheme on a few long term items in support of our capital planning program. The results of this test will be evaluated and appropriate modifications made. A Licensing Section guideline will be developed to implement the use of the priority scheme in the Licensing Section.

Our next status report will be approximately June 14, 1983.
