This is to increase the quantity of LEU to be exported under license XSNM-02001.

The new amounts of material are 1,513 kg of uranium, contained in 44,500 kg of total uranium (instead of 995 kg of U<sub>235</sub> contained in 29,246 kg of total uranium per our Jan. 12, 1983 letter).

The other data contained in our letter of Jan. 12, 1983, remain unchanged.

Please note that the BIBLIS power plant, in which above material will be irradiated, is a facility owned by the final consignee RWE, Essen, West Germany, authorized by our letter of January 12, 1983.
