Appalachia -- Science in the Public Interest requests an extension of time to file its previously submitted, Amicus Curiae Brief from Appalachia-Science in the Public Interest Supporting the Miami Valley Power Preject's Renewed Attempt to Obtain Atomic Safety and Licensing Beard Hearings en Eight Quality Assurance Cententions. The reasons for this request fellow:

- 1) The brief was mistakenly filed early because a) the organization's representative on nuclear issues was not familiar with the specific legal requirements for dates of filing support briefs; and b) was called out of town before the petition was filed so was out of touch with the Government Accountability Project when it pestpened the filing of the petition.
- 2) The brief is a statement of support rather than an original argument. Therefore, filing the brief late would not prejudice the interests of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff or Cincinnati Gas and Electric. There is nothing new in the brief that they might wish to answer.
