This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Messrs. F. J. Jablonski and J. S. Berggren of this office on June 21-25, 1983, of activities at the Clinton Power Station, Unit 1, authorized by NRC Construction Permit No. CPPR-137 and to the discussion of our findings with you at the conclusion of the inspection.


