Gentlemen:

We are hereby requesting an amendment to the subject license, specifically to the statement in our letter of July 1, 1982 (see item 17 of license), in which we specify that:

"Additional information training for the radiation safety officer will be provided by the manufacturer of the Ohmart Corporation facilities.

This training will include:

- a) Safety principles and practices for radioactive materials
- b) Biological EFFECTS of radiation
- c) Radiactivity measurements and instruments
- d) Protective equipment requirements."

We want to eliminate the above statement, since it is more restrictive than the NRC's regulations, inasmuch as they state that "for routine use of a device containing sealed sources, the training provided by the manufacturer at the time of installation is sufficient to qualify individual users."

We are enclosing ammendment fee of \$40.00.
