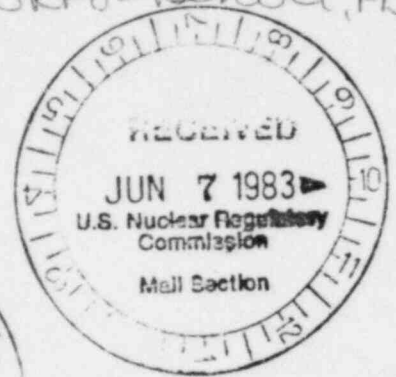
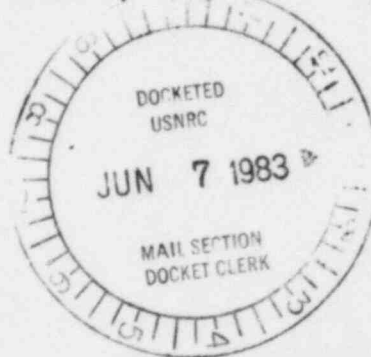

Dear Mr. Smith:

The Edgemont Uranium Mill license SUA-816 requires, by license conditions Nos. 19 and 25, that final decommissioning plans regarding mill site area cleanup and disposal site design be provided by July 1, 1983 for NRC review and approval. Due to delays in completing all final detailed work plans for the decommissioning project, we request that these subject license conditions be amended to read September 30, 1983.

As discussed with members of your staff, TVA will submit to you before September 30, 1983 portions of the overall plans for your review and approval. The intent of the submittals will be to obtain NRC approval of preparatory work activities so that TVA can proceed in a timely manner.

Early review and approval of these activities will allow TVA to develop a uniform sequential work schedule and will lead into actual disposal site activities commencing in FY 1984.
