PVNGS' resident inspector identified an item of concern during a recent NRC Inspection, Reference (A), that warranted additional management attention. A need for definition of responsibility and authority, particularly when activities involve several organizational units, was recognized. PVNGS has delineated these responsibilities as follows:

The Manager of Nuclear Operations will exercise the authority for completely resolving problems which develop in systems which have been accepted by PVNGS Operations. Likewise, the Startup Manager will be responsible for all systems not yet accepted by PVNGS Operations, as well as those accepted systems given back to Bechtel via the Startup Turnover Work Order.
