I would like to request further information on two questions of concern to Nebraska as the host state for the low level radioactive site in our regional compact. These questions are:

2. Can the emergency access clause be interpreted such that if the Nebraska site was operating and other compacts weren't, Nebraska could be required to take other compact wastes pursuant to emergency access provisions?
