Dear Mr. Keppler:

This is to provide information regarding liftoff test of tendons stressed at Braidwood using gauges which were later found to be out of tolerance. This matter was discussed in the inspection report attached to reference (a) and was the subject of a Notice of Violation.

In responding to the Notice of Violation we indicated that a liftoff test would be performed on the last tendon stressed on each day the gauges were found to be out of tolerance. The results of these tests would be evaluated by the architect-engineer to determine if further action is necessary. We expected to be able to supply a report of this evaluation by June 30, 1982. It now appears that the testing will be done in October of 1982 and that our final report will be available by December 31, 1982.
