
MOTION FOR LEAVE TO
FILE OUT OF TIME

Consumers Power Company ("Licensee") hereby moves the Licensing Board to enter an Order extending, by one day to October 12, 1982, the time for filing a Motion for Clarification and/or a Petition for Reconsideration of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board's Partial Initial Decision of September 14, 1982. In support of the Motion, Licensee states:

Licensee requested and was granted a time extension to October 11, 1982 within which to file a motion for clarification or petition for reconsideration. In making that request, Licensee failed to take account of the fact that October 11 had been set aside to honor the achievement of that great Italian explorer, Christopher Columbus. Accordingly, counsel's secretary did not work on October 11, and by the time counsel realized his plight it was too late to secure the required expertise to type, process and file Licensee's Motion.

For good cause shown and because no other party has been prejudiced by the one-day delay, Licensee's Motion should be granted.
