 - a. Drawing should be revised to show all of the features described in Sections 1.2.1, 2.1.1 and the details of the drum closure as described in Section 4.1.4.
 - b. Drawing should show the details of the welded bottom plate described in NFS letter of November 17, 1965.
 - c. Provide a justification for, or delete, the option to use a 55-gallon drum which is equivalent to DOT Specification 17H.
2. Section 7.1.b. Procedures for loading the package. The installation of a 1" x 4-3/4" diameter wood block, as required by Section 2.5, should be included in the instruction.
