Dear Judges Kelley, Bright & Carpenter:

After a couple of failures to catch Tom Baxter, I spoke with John O'Neill (CP&L attorney) today concerning the Harris operating cost data which Applicants had earlier said would be filed in ER Amendment 4, which is not in there. These are the cost data required "to be beaten" prima facie in a 10 CFR 2.758 petition concerning need for power.

C'Neill says these data were not included since many computer runs are required for the sensitivity analysis of operating costs for the CP&L system with and without Harris, which CP&L is doing. He hopes to get this data filed in a further ER amendment by the end of 1982, but said he should not be held to that date.

Given that the delay seems to be in CP&L's producing the data,

I think it best to wait for it (rather than conduct discovery on
this question now) and then file such further discovery as may be
required re my admitted capacity factor contention, and re operating
costs. I will do this and file a 2.2758 petition and affidavit(s)
as promptly as possible, once CP&L produces the pecessary data,
as I have said in my 10-15-82 filling.
