Dear Mr. Denton:

This is to request withholding of proprietary information  
from public disclosure.

In references (a) and (b) revisions to Appendix C of the  
Byron/Braidwood FSAR were submitted to the NRC. The revisions were  
made as a result of changes to turbine missile information supplied  
by Westinghouse Electric Corporation.

When the revised sections of Appendix C were prepared,  
proprietary Westinghouse information was inadvertently included  
without a request to the NRC for withholding from public disclosure.  
Recently, Westinghouse was informed of this oversight and they have  
requested that the information be withdrawn from the public domain  
and henceforth withheld from disclosure.

As the attachments to References (a) and (b) contain  
proprietary to Westinghouse Electric Corporation, they are supported  
by an attached affidavit signed by Westinghouse, the owner of the  
information. The affidavit sets forth the basis on which the infor-  
mation may be withheld from public disclosure by the Commission and  
addresses with specificity the considerations listed in paragraph  
(b)(4) of Section 2.790 of the Commission's regulations.


