Dear Mr. Denton:

This is to request withholding of proprietary information from public disclosure.

In references (a) and (b) revisions to Appendix C of the Byron/Braidwood FSAR were submitted to the NRC. The revisions were made as a result of changes to turbine missile information supplied by Westinghouse Electric Corporation.

When the revised sections of Appendix C were prepared, proprietary Westinghouse information was inadvertently included without a request to the NRC for withhol ing from public disclosure. Recently, Westinghouse was informed of this oversight and they have requested that the information be withdrawn from the public domain and henceforth withheld from disclosure.

As the attachments to References (a) and (b) contain proprietary to Westinghove Electric Corporation, they are supported by an attached affidation igned by Westinghouse, the owner of the information. The sets forth the basis on which the information may be with the public disclosure by the Commission and addresses with specificity the considerations listed in paragraph (b)(4) of Section 2.790 of the Commission's regulations.

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Accordingly, it is respectfully requested that the information which is proprietary to Westinghouse be withdrawn from the public domain and withheld from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR Section 2.790 of the Commission's regulations.
