The Federal Emergency Management Agency (acting as a part of the staff of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission) proposes the following cross-examination plan for the Westchester County supplemental testimony it received on January 3, 1983. Portions of the Westchester original and supplemental testimony contains outdated material, errors of fact and some statements that could be misinterpreted. We anticipate asking clarifying questions in the following areas:

1. Familiarity with the Federal Emergency Management Agency's update report of December 16, 1982 to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

2. The present status of, and future plans for, dosimeter distribution to Westchester County.
3. The present status of, and plans for improvement of, radio communications in Westchester County.
4. Availability of radiological emergency preparedness training.
5. The familiarity of Westchester County officials with the details of New York State and County plans and with meetings involving State, County, utility and Federal government representatives during the "120 day clock" period.
6. The need for expenditure of radiological emergency preparedness funds for additional equipment, personnel and information sought by Westchester County.


