

SUBJECT: Reopening of Significant Construction Deficiencies 42 and 48

Dear Mr. Collins,

As a result of a NRC site review of SCD files for which final reports have been submitted by LP&L, it has been determined that the final reports submitted for SCD's 42 and 48 do not adequately describe the scope of the corrective action performed. The Nonconformance Reports (MCR's) used to identify the problem and track the corrective action have been reopened. Upon disposition of these NCR's, LP&L will resubmit final reports for SCD's 42 and 48. It is anticipated that final reports on these SCD's will be transmitted to the NRC by February 14, 1983.
