Dear Mr. Norelius:

I am replying to your letter of November 30, 1990 to Associate Regional Administrator Dorothy Collins regarding the allegation of improper care at Cleveland Clinic Hospital. Staff at the HCFA Regional Office have reviewed the materials enclosed with the letter, including the results of your investigations of the incidents.

Our investigations of allegations against hospitals participating in the Medicare program are limited to determining if the hospital is out of the compliance with the Medicare Conditions of Participation. These Conditions do not cover the practice of medicine by a physician while in the hospital. It is evident that your investigations thoroughly explored the policies and practices of Cleveland Clinic Hospital as they relate to possession and use of radioactive material. The Health Care Financing Administration certainly has no reason to question your findings in this area.

Allegations of medical malpractice in Ohio are investigated by the Ohio State Medical Board. I suggest that your refer this complaint to them. The address is:
