Turkey Point Units 3 and 4 Docket Nos. 50-250 and 50-251 Physical Security Plan Revision 8 Submittal Under 10 CFR 50.54 (p)

Florida Power and Light Company (FPL) has issued Revision 8 to the Turkey Point Physical Security Plan and has determined that the revision does not decrease the safeguards effectiveness of the plan. Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.54 (p), a report describing the revision and copies PTNPSP-3 through PTNPSP-6 of the plan are enclosed. The report enclosed includes directions for incorporating Revision 8 into the plan, a summary of the changes, a revised list of effective pages and copies of Revision 8 of the plan.
