We have reviewed the letter dated November 11, 2019 regarding NRC License No. 24-32591-01 issued to Leidos, Inc. It appears that in Attachment 1, Leidos requests to name Charles (Chuck) Finkenbine as the Radiation Safety Officer (RSO). Please provide information for the following.

- 1) Confirm that the licensee will not use licensed material as tracers in field studies/field applications.
- 2) Provide a delegation of authority for the new RSO with signatures of the new RSO and the authorized management (see attached sample).
- 3) Provide the specific training and experience of the new RSO, and include the specific dates of training in radiation safety (at a minimum a college degree in physical, chemical, biological sciences, or engineering at the bachelor's level or equivalent; at least 40 hours in formal course(s) of radiation safety training designed for RSOs, presented by an academic institution, commercial radiation safety consulting company, or a professional organization of radiation protection experts; and at least a year of experience with similar radionuclides, forms, quantities, and uses authorized in the license). Alternatively, Leidos could provide alternative information demonstrating that the proposed RSO is qualified by training and experience (e.g., Board Certification by the American Board of Health Physicists, completion of a bachelor's and/or master's degree in the sciences with at least 1 year of experience in the conduct of a radiation safety program of comparable size and scope).
