As you my be aware, The Armed Forces Radiobiology Research Institute (AFRRI) is currently under review by the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board for renewal of a license to operate a nuclear research reactor on the grounds of the National Naval Medical Center, in Bethesda, Maryland.
