Thank you for your letter of July 10, 1981, informing us of steps you have taken to correct the violations and deviations concerning activities under NRC Operacing License Nos. NPF-4 and NPF-7 brought to your attention in our letter of June 16, 1981. Regarding Violation A, it is our understanding, based on telephone conversations between this office and Mr. E. Smith and Mr. J. Harper on July 29, 1981, that the date when full compliance will be achieved has been changed to June 30, 1982. Regarding Violation F, we have evaluated your response and concur with the additional clarification involving the signatures on the comprehensive examination records being maintained in the individual's personnel records at the company offices. This example of failure to follow procedures is withdrawn; however, the failure to list the Quality Assurance category on purchase requisitions 42437 and 41159 remains the basis of the violation as stated.

Regarding Violations A. B. C. D. E and F and Deviations A and B. we will examine your corrective actions and plans during subsequent inspections.
