Please find under separate cover, (40) copies of Amendment 60 to the Allens Creek Nuclear Generating Station, Preliminary Safety Analysis Report. A copy of this transmittal letter is attached to each amendment copy.

Amendment 60 consists of changes necessary to provide responses to questions concerning the emergency plan. These questions were transmitted to Houston Lighting & Power Company by letter from Robert L. Tedesco, dated June 4, 1981. The emergency plan information is identical to that previously supplied in our letter from J. H. Goldberg to Harold Denton dated July 16, 1981, except for additional information that was later requested. This additional information is included in this amendment in Sections 13.3.6.6, 13.3.7.2.1 and Figure 13.3-6. Figure 2-2 of Appendix 13.3B has been updated and is also included in this amendment.

Additionally, Amendment 60 contains clarifications to the LPG pipeline analysis in PSAR Section 2.2A. Conclusions reached as a result of the analysis have not been changed by this amendment.


