Pursuant to Section 50.59 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Corporation hereby proposes the following modifications to Appendix A of the Operating License.

Proposed Change

Replace pages ii through iv, and pages 187-f through i and add pages 187-j through m, using the attached pages. It is intended that the revised pages transmitted by this letter supercede in their entirety those pages previously forwarded by Reference (b). Pages i through iv have been revised to update the index to Vermont Yankee Technical Specifications.

Reason for Change

Reference (b) was submitted to update the Technical Specifications to reflect the current compliment of fire protection systems installed at Vermont Yankee. The revised Technical Specification pages transmitted by this letter reflect comments received from the NRC staff regarding Reference (b). In addition, an updated index has been included in this submittal.

Safety Considerations

Fee Determination

This proposed change requires an approval that involves a single fire protection issue and is deemed not to involve a significant hazards consideration. For these reasons, Vermont Yankee proposes this change as a Class III Amendment. A payment of \$4,000.00 was submitted with Reference (b).


