12. DESCRIPTION OF AMENDMENT/MODIFICATION

1. Regarding ARTICLE I - STATEMENT OF WORK

A. Part C. - Specific Tasks - The contract is modified to include subtask 7(c) and 7(d) as follows:

"Subtask 7(c): Development and testing of a multistate review procedure for determining need for nuclear facilities.

Element 1. The Contractor will gather information on procedures for determining need for nuclear facilities which are currently used or being developed. As part of this element, the Contractor will examine relevant information developed by the Department of Energy.

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Except as provided herein, all terms and conditions of the document referenced in block 8, as heretofore changed, remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

Element 2. The Contractor, with the assistance of participating states, will review the information gathered in Element 1 and the information developed in prior subtasks to determine the applicability of multistate review procedures for determining need for power in the NEPA framework to other types of nuclear facilities, with particular emphasis on need for low-level radioactive waste disposal facilities. The Contractor will document the findings in Element 2 in a form suitable for inclusion in a report to be delivered to NRC at the conclusion of the contract.

Subtask 7(d): Development and testing of a procedure for a multistate review of alternative sites for nuclear facilities.

Element 1. The Contractor will gather information on procedures for alternative site review which are currently used or being developed for nuclear facilities, hazardous waste facilities, or other related facilities. The Contractor will document the alternative site review procedures that are in place or being developed.

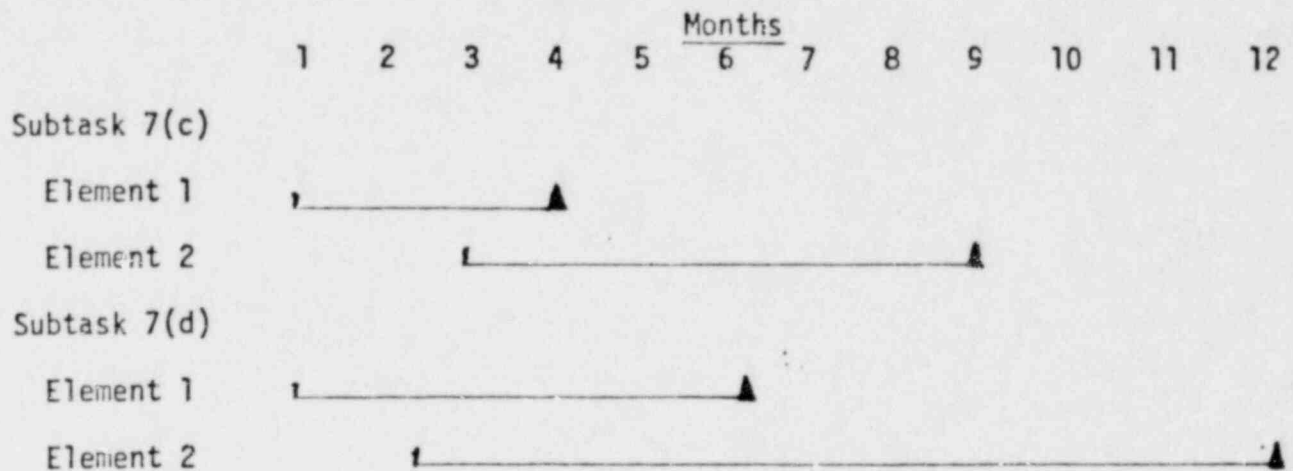
Element 2. The Contractor, with the assistance of participating states, will review the information gathered in Element 1 and the information developed in prior subtasks to determine the applicability of multistate review procedures for fixed nuclear reactors to alternative site review for generic nuclear facilities with particular emphasis on alternative site review procedures for low-level radioactive waste disposal facility sites. Factors to be considered in determining the applicability of multistate review procedures will include the public participation program subelements developed in prior subtasks. The evaluation of applicability should pertain to siting actions planned or initiated by either private sector or state entities. The Contractor will document the findings in Element 2 in a form suitable for inclusion in a report to be delivered to NRC at the conclusion of the contract."

B. Part D - Reports - The following report requirements are hereby added:

- "7. The contractor shall submit a monthly letter progress report to the NRC Contracting Officer's Project Officer (PO) and one copy to the Contracting Officer (CO) by the 15th day of each month. This report shall state the progress made, problems incurred and solutions proposed, and plans for the ensuing month, as well as, a summary of costs incurred."
- "8. The contractor shall furnish the NRC with a complete technical report on the work completed for subtask 7(c) and 7(d). This report shall be prepared in accordance with NRC Manual Chapter 3202 and shall be delivered in an original and three copies. This report is due upon completion of this contract."

- C. The work to be performed under A. hereof shall be completed in accordance with the following schedule.

2. Regarding ARTICLE II - PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE

The period of performance is revised to continue through a completion date of September 15, 1982.

3. This work shall be performed in accordance with the contractors proposal dated July 16, 1980.
