Dear Mr. Christiana:

This is in further response to your letter dated November 13, 1980 in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, a copy of all data relating to the recent accident which occurred in Indian Point, Unit 2.

Five documents subject to your request were inadvertently excluded from my June letter.

The documents listed on the appendix are enclosed. Also, correspondence from the general public about the accident is available for inspection and copying in the Indian Point 2 Docket File located at the NRC's Public Document Room, 1717 H Street, N.W., Washington, DC 20555. Item 3 of the appendix is one such piece of correspondence.

The documents listed below contain information which constitutes advice, opinions and recommendations of the staff. This information is being withheld from public disclosure pursuant to Exemption (5) of the Freedom of Information Act (5 U.S.C. 552(b)(5)) and 10 CFR 9.5(a)(5) of the Commission's regulations.

Pursuant to 10 CFR 9.15 of the Commission's regulations, it has been determined that the information withheld is exempt from production or disclosure and that its production or disclosure is contrary to the public intere t. The person responsible for this denial is Mr. Samuel J. Chilk, Secretary of the Commission.

This denial may be appealed to the Commission within 30 days from the receipt of this letter. Any such appeal must be in writing, addressed to the Secretary of the Commission, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Washington, DC 20555, and should clearly state on the envelope and in the letter that it is an "Appeal from an Initial FOIA Decision."
