been submitted and accepted? Is this required
before a license for a Facility Operating is
issued?

At present there is an investigation in
progress of Limerick. To avoid conflict the
Application should be held aside now.

for nuclear plants as a source of electricity.
The construction has proved very expensive
the life of a plant is too short for that
amount of investment. The decommissioning
costs and means are undetermined. Low
level radiation is a real threat to the area
of the plant. The plant is too near population.
